Parking

I have been informed by residents of Beanlands and indeed residents of The Hawthorns, about inconsiderate parking on the residential roads adjacent to school. This includes: parking on double yellow lines without the relevant permit, turning/reversing in private driveways and restricting access by parking on pavements. I ask parents to please be considerate to our neighbours especially at this festive time of 'goodwill to all men' (and women, and our neighbours).

- 1) Only park on double yellow lines if you have a permit e.g. a blue badge.
- 2) Perform a 3 point turn without using a private driveway,
- 3) Allow access for pedestrians, wheel chairs and buggies.

I understand that residents have also contacted other 'authorities' regarding their concerns, therefore there may be a 'presence on patrol'. Please abide by the highway-code.
