## New developments to the school campus

A meeting was held this week regarding building work commencing at school over the Summer holidays.

The developments will see the installation of two new modern classrooms with facilities that will provide an excellent teaching and learning environment for the school's pupils and staff. As our school continues to grow in number and popularity the new classrooms will enable us to meet the demand for places.

There will also be a new footpath installed linking KS1 and KS2 playgrounds, new car parking spaces for staff and an extension to the KS2 playground to join up with the outdoor picnic area, as well as a new roof placed above the staffroom in the KS2 building. Children in classes 12 and 13 from September 2017, will be directed where to line up on the first morning back in school (5<sup>th</sup> September).

Work will commence on the 17<sup>th</sup> July – this is when children will still be in school. There will also be Sports' Day taking place on the 18<sup>th</sup> July with many visitors on site, **parking is only available for disabled badge users**. The school will be working with contractors and NYCC Health and Safety advisors to ensure that all site users are kept safe with minimal disruption. All work is planned to be completed by Monday 28<sup>th</sup> August.
