Anti-Bullying Week 2017: 13th – 17th November

Anti-Bullying Week 2017 is happening from Monday 13th – Friday 17th November and has the theme: 'All Different, All Equal'.

It is co-ordinated by the Anti-Bullying alliance which is based at the National Children's Bureau.

The aims of the week are to:

- Empower children and young people to celebrate what makes them, and others, unique.
- Help people and young people to understand how important it is that every child feels valued and included in school, able to be themselves, without fear of bullying.
- Encourage parents and carers to work with their school and talk to their children about bullying, difference and equality.
- Enable teachers and school support staff to celebrate what makes us 'all different, all equal' by celebrating difference and equality and taking individual and collective action to prevent bullying, creating safe environments where children can be themselves.

Our Anti-Bullying Ambassadors have organised a range of events and activities for us to take part in during the week.

These include:

- Odd Socks Day – This will be on **Monday 13th November**. We would like everybody to wear odd socks for the day. This will create an opportunity for children to express themselves and to celebrate individuality.
- A special assembly.
- We will be selling anti-bullying wristbands and rulers for £1 each-a limited supply.
