The following expectations and guidance should be read in conjunction with the Remote Learning Policy which was published on Class Dojo on Monday 12th October.

Guidance for Online Learning at Home

- Make sure your child understands and is aware of these pupil guidelines
- Supervise your child's internet use and online learning – make sure you are aware of what they have been asked to do and the websites they need to access.
- Make sure you know who your child is talking to or messaging.
- If a member of staff calls to speak to your children – check that you know who they are, speak to the member of staff yourself before your child talks to them, stay in the room while your child is on the phone.

Expectations for All Video Calls and Video lessons

- The parent or carer must make sure their child and other members of the household are aware that the video call is happening,
- Staff, children and other members of the household must wear suitable clothing – Parents must ensure that their child wears a school jumper and is shown from the waist up only if on screen.
- Devices used should be in appropriate areas and where possible be against a neutral background.
- Language must be professional and appropriate, including any family members in the background.
- The same expectations apply for remote teaching and conversations as normal school conduct
- At no point should a child or their parent/ family member take screen shots or record online video lessons or conversations.
- If the teacher has any concerns about children (or other members of the household) using unsuitable language, dress or location, the conversation will be ended and concerns will be recorded and passed to the Headteacher or Deputy Headteacher.
- Please provide snacks and lunch for your child whilst they are OFF screen.
- If your child takes part in a group video conversation, they can be seen by the teacher and other pupils (and members of their household) that are part of the conversation.
