Local walks and activities

Local risk assessed walks.

In order to enhance the curriculum and to provide a variety of exciting learning opportunities and experiences for children, teachers may wish to take children out of school within the locality. These experiences will involve classes / groups of children *walking to* local points of interests.

This includes local walks to:

Airedale Hospital, Sutton-in-Craven Park, Glusburn Park, St Thomas's Church Sutton, Sutton Baptist Church, Cross Hills Evangelical Church, Cross Hills Coop, Cross Hills Police Station, Glusburn Institute, Sutton Wood, Sutton Clough, Cross Hills Post Office and local schools: Sutton, Kildwick, South Craven

A risk assessment will be completed for all activities and visits. This will be signed by all participating adults.

The risk assessment includes:

- Date, Year Group, number of pupils, accompanying adults, named Leader
- Details of pupils attending including special needs, inclusion, dietary, medical and control measures
- Details of the site and environment and control measures
- Details of the activity arrangements and control measures
- Details of alternative plans for example in the case of wet weather
- Emergency contact telephone numbers

On entry into school parents are asked to indicate their consent local walks and activities. This consent is considered valid for the time their child is registered at the school unless parents specifically inform the school in writing of withdrawal of consent. Consent is given electronically.

Extract from the Parent Consent form:

"Local Walks: I give consent for my child to leave the school premises to take part in local walks for which there is a risk assessment in line with the Local Walks and Activities information (please see link below). I also understand that my child may attend residential trips and adventurous activities when separate consent will be required from me."
